PMEGP Loan of Rs.298.44 crore sanctioned and PMEGP Margin Money subsidy of Rs.100.16 Crore disbursed in Bhiwani, Haryana

On 14th March 2023, Delhi: Chairman, Khadi and Village Industries Commission Shri Manoj Kumar released margin money grant of Rs.100.16 crore in favour of 2989 beneficiaries under Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme.



These beneficiaries have been sanctioned Rs.298.44 crore by banks for setting up enterprises under PMEGP in Jhumpa, Bhiwani ,Haryana. About 24,000 people will get additional employment through these un its set up by these beneficiaries. In addition Rs 4.44 crore margin money grant amount was also disbursed to PMEGP beneficiaries of Haryana against the sanctioned loan amount of Rs 13.67 crore.

Speaking on the occasion Shri Manoj Kumar said that the 'Prime Minister's Employment Generation Program (PMEGP)' is playing an

important role in realizing Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's dream of 'Atmanirbhar Bharat'. He said KVIC through its schemes and various programmes, is generating employment opportunities for artisans at their doorstep in remote areas at a very low cost.

On the occasion, Under the Leather Artisan's Empowerment Program, advanced tool-kits for footwear manufacturing were distributed through online mode to 50 beneficiaries of Haryana and 50 beneficiaries each of Chomu area and Maujmabad of Rajasthan. Under the 'Honey Mission' scheme of KVIC, 400 Bee-

boxes for bee-keeping were also distributed online to 40 trained beneficiaries of Haryana . Additionally, paper conversion machines were distributed to 20 beneficiaries of Punjab under Handmade Paper manufacturing Scheme, and peddle operated Agarbatti machines too were distributed online to 40 beneficiaries of Shivdaspura-Rajasthan under Agarbatti Nirman Yojana.

Shri Kumar said through these schemes efforts are being made to upgrade skills and improve the economic and social status of maximum artisans by providing them tool kits, so that we can move forward in building a prosperous, strong, self-reliant and happy nation. He also sad that these entrepreneur should set an inspiration for other youth and like Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi's Vision they should be able to provide jobs instead of being job seeker. Under the PMEGP scheme,

Government has also increased the maximum cost of the project from Rs.25 lakh to Rs.50 lakh, and in the service sector it has been increased from Rs.10 lakh to Rs.20 lakh. To establish these PMEGP units Government provides 15% to 25% of the entire project cost as grant to the beneficiaries in urban areas, and 25% to 35% in rural areas. After loan approval, free entrepreneurship training is also provided



to the beneficiaries in relation to establishment of their chosen enterprises.

Shri Kumar also interacted with artisans, representatives of Khadi institutions and entrepreneurs of Khadi and Village Industries through "Khadi Jagran" organized to encourage the ongoing Khadi and Village Industries programs in Haryana.





KVIC Chairman Inaugurated KVI Exhibition at Varanasi

During the inaugural program of the exhibition, Chairman, KVIC distributed margin money grant amount of Rs 77.45 crore on the sanctioned loan of Rs 227.21 crore to 2215 beneficiaries of Central and East Zone under the Prime Minister's

Earlier, Hon'ble Chairman distributed 180 electric potter wheels in Khadi Gramodyog Vikas Samiti, Marui, Sindhaura and inaugurated a unit costing of Rs. 5 lakhs for 10 trainees trained from Central Paduka Training Institute, Agra under Leather Craft Scheme. He also distributed improved footwear repairing toolkits to 75 leather artisans.

In his inaugural speech Chairman Shri Manoj Kumar said that the Khadi and Village Industries Commission has increased the wages of cotton weavers by 33 percent from April 1, 2023. Earlier spinners were given Rs 7.50 per hank, it has been increased to Rs 10., The wages of spinners, weavers have increased by 150 percent since 2014.

After distribution of various livelihood resources and grant amount under several schemes for employment generation,

Chairman, KVIC Distributed Margin Money Grants and Bee Boxes in Kaithal, Haryana

On 31 MARCH 2023 Delhi: Shri Manoj Kumar, Chairman, Khadi and Village Industries Commission, released margin money grant of Rs. 245.61 crore to 9966 beneficiaries under the Prime Minister's Employment Generation Program (PMEGP) scheme in a program in Delhi.

These beneficiaries have been sanctioned Rs. 739.65 crore by the banks to set up enterprises under the scheme. Through these units, an estimated 79,728 people will get additional employment.

PMEGP in realizing the vision of a self-reliant India as envisaged by Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi. Interactive session with the artisans community was very refreshing as it helped me to understand their day to day pursuits and


