Sub:- Annual Progress Report of PMEGP for the year 2008-09 – reg.

As we all aware that, Ministry of MSME, Govt. of India has launched Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), a very ambitious scheme for generating employment opportunities across the country. The monitoring of the various dimensions of the scheme is very essential to take corrective measures for better results.

2. For the purpose of effective monitoring formats have been designed to monitor and evaluate various dimensions of the scheme. The detailed set of format may please be compiled in all respects by including the data relating to KVIC/KVIB & DICs. Since the data of each implementing agency are to be scrutinized, as such first data of each agency is to be filled in and subsequently a compiled statement for the state as a whole is to be prepared.

3. For the reporting year 2008-09 the compiled information of KVIB/DIC on prescribed format should reach to the State Office latest by 5th July-2009. The State/Divisional Director of KVIC will collect and compile data of whole State and sent the detailed report latest by 10th July-2009 for the cases sanctioned by bank upto 31/3/2009 and settled on or before 30th June-2009. The projects sanctioned on or after 1-04-2009 should not be included in the report of 2008-09.

4. For compilation of data and estimation in respect of production, sale, employment and earnings for the year 2008-09 and there after, the following formula may please be adopted

Production : One and half times of project cost will be the Production (in case of Service Industry group, no production value should be calculated as there will not be any production in this group. However, in case of Textile etc.. production value may be calculated and included accordingly).

Sales : 25% increase over and above production cost (including Service Industry Group).

Employment : On an average 9-10 persons per project.

Earnings : 55% of the project cost.
